- <sup>1</sup> I cry out to God; yes, I shout.

- <sup>2</sup> When I was in deep trouble,

- <sup>3</sup> I think of God, and I moan,  
overwhelmed with longing for his help.
- <sup>4</sup> You don't let me sleep.  
I am too distressed even to pray!
- <sup>5</sup> I think of the good old days,  
long since ended,
- <sup>6</sup> when my nights were filled with joyful songs.  
I search my soul and ponder the difference now.
- <sup>7</sup> Has the Lord rejected me forever?  
Will he never again be kind to me?
- <sup>8</sup> Is his unfailing love gone forever?  
Have his promises permanently failed?
- <sup>9</sup> Has God forgotten to be gracious?  
Has he slammed the door on his compassion?
- <sup>10</sup> And I said, “This is my fate;  
the Most High has turned his hand against me.”
- <sup>11</sup> But then I recall all you have done, O LORD;  
I remember your wonderful deeds of long ago.
- <sup>12</sup> They are constantly in my thoughts.  
I cannot stop thinking about your mighty works.
- <sup>13</sup> O God, your ways are holy.  
Is there any god as mighty as you?
- <sup>14</sup> You are the God of great wonders!  
You demonstrate your awesome power among the nations.
- <sup>15</sup> By your strong arm, you redeemed your people,  
the descendants of Jacob and Joseph.
